

Dear Resident

We are pleased to advise that work is due to start on **Phase One** of the **Southsea Coastal Scheme** (the Scheme) in your local area from 7 September 2020 until summer 2022.

This essential work will replace the existing, ageing sea defences, protecting communities and properties from the risk of flooding while improving the seafront and preserving the area's unique heritage.

The site boundary of Phase One (Long Curtain Moat) extends from the Saluting Platform to the entrance of Clarence Pier Car Park. In addition, work will also commence on the Scheme's primary site compound and offices adjacent to Pier Road (please see the maps overleaf). This compound area will be closed from September 2020 until 2026.

Here are a few points you may find helpful over this time:

- Works will include the construction of a primary compound area, demolition of the existing seawall, installation of sheet piling and placement of precast concrete units and rock.
- Some of the equipment used will be cranes, excavators, tipper trucks and a large dredging ship that will bring shingle to shore to form a temporary working platform.
- The Clarence Pier Carpark will be closed while works are in progress.
- Parts of the footpath from the Saluting Platform across Long Curtain Moat will be closed, with a diversion around the Royal Garrison Church and behind Kings Bastion.
- The scheme has planned for the majority of work to take place on weekdays between 7am and 7pm, to avoid inconvenience and noise for residents.
- Occasionally, it may be necessary for work restricted by the tide to occur outside these times and we will do our best to advise you if and when this is likely to occur.
