Rules of the Competition

By entering the competition, schools and entrants confirm that they have read and understood, and agree to be bound by, the following competition rules:

1) The competition is open to the following schools in the locality of the Southsea Coastal Scheme Project:

2) Entries must be designed on A3 or A4 paper, or electronic entries should be printable on A3 or A4 paper. Design can be electronically, drawing, painting or image montage.

3) Entries must be delivered via post or handed in to Southsea Coastal Scheme Project Office in Southsea and marked 'SOUTHSEA COASTAL SCHEME ART COMPETITION', Pier Road, Southsea, Portsmouth, PO5 3AP, or emailed to southseacoastalscheme@portsmouthcc.gov.uk

4) Only one entry to the competition per person shall be accepted.

5) Entries must be received no later than 4.00 pm on Tuesday 30th November 2021

6) Each individual entry must have the following information written clearly on the back of the artwork or in the body of the email application, otherwise it will not be considered:

- Pupil's full name, class, year group and school name.

7) Subject to paragraph 10 below, artwork can be collected from the Pier Road Visitor Centre, if it is not selected for exhibition.

8) Winners and runners up will be informed of the results by 5.00 pm on Tuesday 14th December 2021.

9) The winners of the competition shall be decided by a panel of judges (including Senior Project Managers, Senior Engineers, PCC Staff, local artists employed on the scheme) who shall decide, in their absolute discretion, the winners. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding, and no correspondence shall be entered into by Southsea Coastal Scheme, or its partners.

10) The copyright for any image entered in the competition shall (as between the entrant and Southsea Coastal Scheme) remain with the entrant. However, entrants' consent to Southsea Coastal Scheme using any of the images for any publicity and/or promotional activities alongside entrants name, age and school details.

Entrants of competition consents to their name, details and their winning work being used on the Southsea Coastal Scheme website and displayed on the hoardings at the Southsea Coastal Scheme Site hoardings at Frontage 4 – Southsea Coastal.

11) There will be two runners up and one overall winner from each category as detailed below:

- Primary Early Years and Key Stage 1: Years R, One and Two
- Key Stage 2: Years Three to Six
- Key Stage 3: Years Seven to Nine
- Key Stage 4: Years Ten and Eleven

Winners will have work publicly displayed on the hoardings for construction work at Frontage 4. Winners and runners up work will be displayed at the Site Visitor Office at Pier Road, Southsea and on the Southsea Coastal Scheme website.

12) Southsea Coastal Scheme and their partners are not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries.

13) All personal data relating to competition entrants will be processed solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation and GDPR.

14) Entry to the competition shall only be valid if the entrant has complied with these competition rules.
